

New District 22 (District 21 prior to the 2002 Reapportionment)

The new District 22 was created to realign Alaska's political districts to reflect new population information gathered in the 2000 U.S. Census.

These boundaries display the homes of approximately 15,000 residents. District 22 is uniquely distinct.

At the north fronting Northway Mall are Penland Park, additional mobile home parks, and shopping areas. South of DeBarr are small communities, such as Airport Heights, Anchor Park, and Russian Jack neighborhoods.

Throughout the district Chester Creek flows through the many small and large parks.

At the middle-eastern to southern boundary are the communities of College Gate and Castle Heights.

Rarely noted for its contribution to Anchorage and Alaska is the University/Medical complex that extends from above DeBarr Road south to Tudor Blvd, and Lake Otis Blvd. east to Boniface Parkway.

Within this area are 3,500 workers in the education sector of the economy, and over 12,000 employees in the health fields. In education, our area hosts a true cross-section of educational facilities and services from preschool to adult learning, including both the University of Alaska Anchorage and Alaska Pacific University. Virtually all of the intensive medical and mental health services and a great many of the social services in Anchorage also have their facilities within the boundaries of this map.

House District 22 is bounded by a line beginning at the intersection of Airport Heights Drive and Penland Parkway, east along the parkway to 7th Avenue to Hoyt Street, south to San Roberto Avenue, east to Pine Street, south to DeBarr Road, east to Boniface Parkway, south to 20th Avenue, east to Penn Circle, south and west to Pembroke Street, south to College Drive, west to Boniface Parkway, south to Tudor Road, west to Dale Street, north to 43rd Avenue, west to Piper Street and north to the southern boundary of the Alaska Psychiatric Institute (API), west to Lake Otis Parkway, north to 20th Avenue, east to Toklat Street, north to 17th Avenue, east to Logan Street, north to 16th Avenue, east to Alder Drive, north to 15th Avenue, east to Airport Heights Drive, north to point of beginning.
